Other agreements in leading, e.g. high level contracts, partnership suits:-

Mostly standard honours BUT V NT honours ask for next card to be dropped so Q from KQT9x etc. Otherwise, honours ask for reverse attitude K ask for count against 5-level or higher suit contracts. This also applies after preempts.

CARDING METHODS
