

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
<b>OVERCALLS (Style; Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)</b>
Natural, can be light at one-level.
Facing 1M: cue = 3-card raise, 2NT (not over pass) = 4T raise.
Three of opener's suit = mixed raise.
New suit forcing opposite two or three-level overcall.
<b>INT OVERCALL (2<sup>nd</sup>/4<sup>th</sup> Live; Responses; Reopening)</b>
15-18 responses as opener
R/O 11-15 with 2C range ENQ.
<b>JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
Intermediate (exception: weak when opponents bid strongly)
2D over 1C = 55M
Reopen: intermediate
<b>DIRECT &amp; JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)</b>
1C-2C = natural, 1C-3C = 5D 5S
2D/M cue = Michaels
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening; PH)</b>
Dble (strong NT and by PH) = 5m 4M (except 3 <sup>rd</sup> NV opening)
Dble (weak NT) = PEN
2C = majors
2D = one major
2M = 5M 4m
<b>VS. PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)</b>
Dble for take-out
Leaping Michaels NF
<b>VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ or 2♣</b>
Dble = majors
1NT = minors, 2NT = reds
<b>OVER OPPONENTS' TAKEOUT DOUBLE</b>
Transfers after 1M from 1NT (also over double of our 1M overcall)
1m-(x)-2NT = weak raise
1H-(x)-2S and 1S-(x)-3H = weak raise, 3M = mixed raise

<b>GENERAL APPROACH AND STYLE</b>
5-card majors, 1C can be two, 1D can also be balanced
2/1 FG
15-17 opening 1NT
<b>SPECIAL BIDS THAT MAY REQUIRE DEFENSE</b>
2D NV = MM weak or 22/24 balanced
2D V = bad weak 2M or 22/24 balanced
2M NV = Mm weak 5/4+
2M V = 6M 8-11
Weak = less than an opening bid, 0-10 depending on position and vulnerability.
Transfers after 1M-(dble) and also 1M overcall.
